GUEST SPEAKER

Jessica Fischer, BSBA/MSBA 2006

Jessica Fischer is the chief financial officer of Charter Communications, where she oversees a range of functions, including accounting, finance, risk management, investor relations and corporate planning. Additionally, she manages Charter's equity and capital markets strategy and execution, as well as M&A and investing activity. She was named CFO in 2021 after rising in the ranks since joining Charter as corporate treasurer in 2017.

In 2018, WashU Olin honored Fischer as one of its "emerging leaders." Fischer was also ranked No. 21 among cable industry operations leaders by Cablefax, an industry trade publication, which has also numbered her among the industry's most powerful women for the past four years.

Before joining Charter, she was a partner in the National Tax Department at EY. In that role, she advised clients on the tax structuring and implementation of partnership transactions, primarily in the media and telecommunications space. That included advising Charter on its acquisition of Time Warner Cable and Bright House Networks in 2016.

In 2006, Fischer earned both her BSBA in accounting and managerial economics and her MSBA with a concentration in accounting from WashU Olin.

Fischer has been a member of WashU's Eliot Benefactor Committee as a way to pay forward the support she received as a scholarship recipient, which made it possible for her to attend Olin.

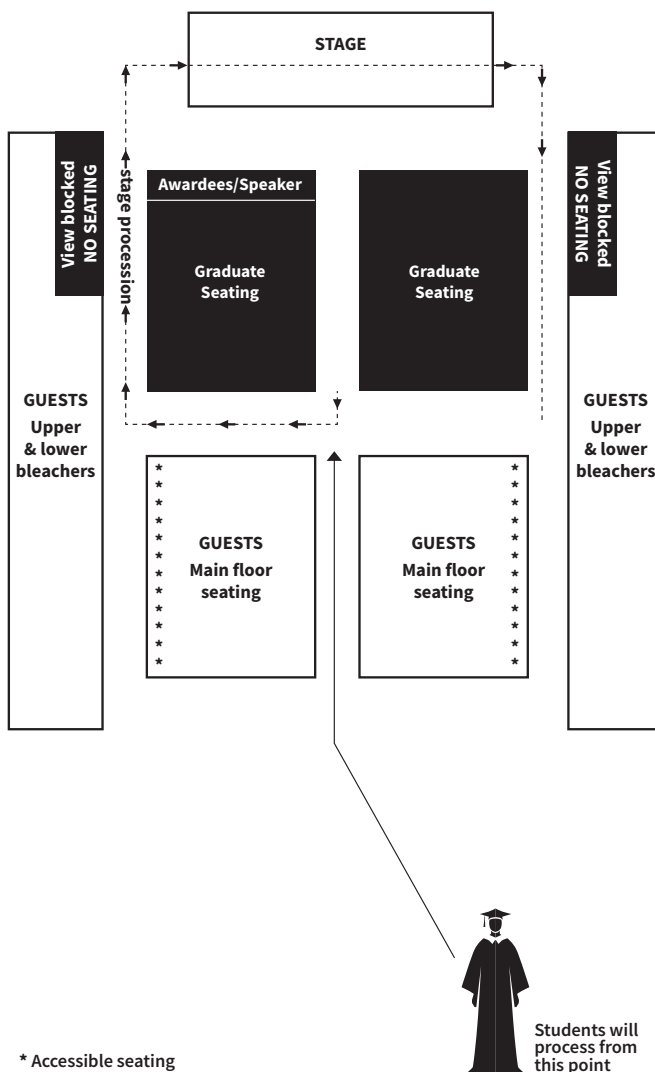
